Postal Target Shooting

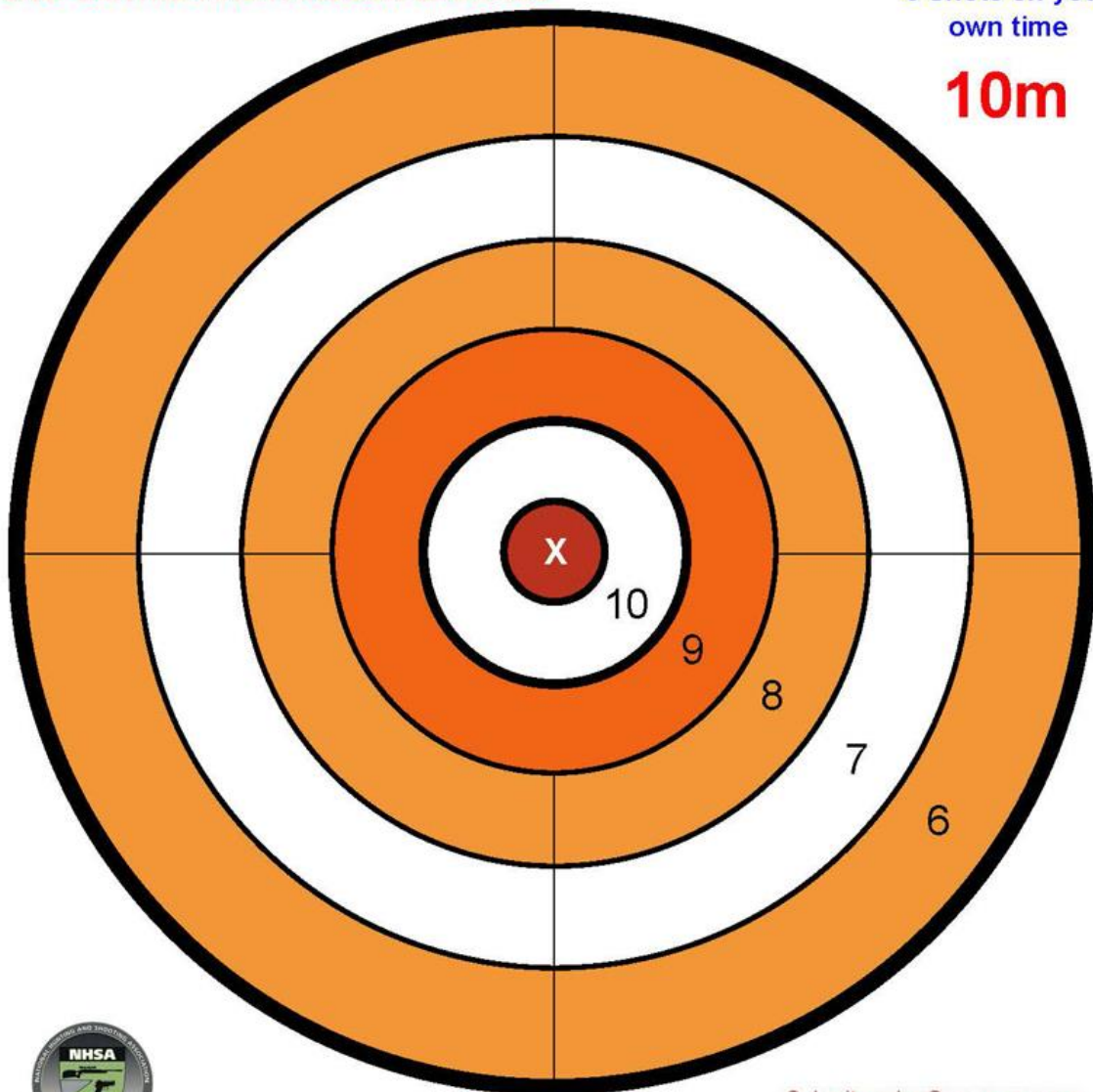
1. This is the official Natshoot Target Shooting Exercises.
2. You download targets for postal exercises from the page for the specific firearm you want to use on the Firearm page on you Natshoot Member Portal.
3. Print the target and shoot (on the right is an example of how all Natshoot Postal Targets look like).
4. Enter the Target score on the Scores Page of your Natshoot Member Portal. Please make sure you fill out all fields with the required information before you submit the postal target and scores.
5. Please do NOT enter postal Targets under Activities on your Natshoot Member Portal as they will be declined there. Only Activity Targets may be entered on the Activities page on your Natshoot Member Portal.

Activity Practice Shooting

1. Members may choose to shoot any target they want to for target practice purposes. This can be a Natshoot Activity Practice Target (example on the right), or it can be any target of a member's own design, or a target you get at your shooting range.
2. You can download Natshoot Activity Practice Targets for target shooting purposes from the page for the specific firearm you want to use on the Firearm page on you Natshoot Member Portal.
3. Print the target and shoot.
4. Enter all Activity Practice Targets under Activities on your Natshoot Member Portal under Activities. Choose Hunting or Sport Shooting related activity - target shooting practice.
5. Please make sure you write the following on the shot target before you submit it:
 - 5.1 Your Initials & Surname and your full ID number;
 - 5.2 The date, firearm make and calibre and name of the shooting range;
 - 5.3 ask someone on the range to sign as a witness that you shot the specific target on the specific date on the specific shooting range.
6. You may also submit a photo of the range register of the day if the shooting range person will allow you to take a photo of the register.
7. Please do NOT enter Activity Practice Targets under Scores on your Natshoot Member Portal as they will be declined there. Only Postal Targets and scores may be entered under Scores on you Natshoot Member Portal.
